## Who We Are

We are a non-profit organization servicing families of our counties in Cumberland, Gloucester, & Salem. We work as a team with the Care Management Organization (CMO) to help support, educate and advocate for families who have children with mental, emotional & behavioral challenges. We are also a resource center for information & contacts. There are 15 FSOs in New Jersey, one for each county.



We are located at 3739 N. Delsea Drive in Vineland, NJ and are open from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

## What We Do

### Education/Advocacy

We provide trainings, workshops, guest speakers & other events that inform and empower our families on an individual and group basis. We also advocate for families as a whole within the various systems which include Justice, DYFS, Mental Health, & Education. We strive to ensure that the family voice is heard at all levels.

### Peer Support Partners

Our Peer Support staff is unique in that each person must have a child who is or has been involved in the system of care. They attend IEPs, meeting with DYFS & make judicial appearances with the families.

### Support Groups

We sponsor Parent's Anonymous which is open to all caregivers who need input on raising children, discuss child rearing issues or just want a sympathetic ear.



## Youth Partnership

The FSO works directly with youth ages 12-21 who have been involved with the mental health, juvenile justice, or child welfare system. We plan activities, teach them appropriate ways to socialize and involve them in the community.
